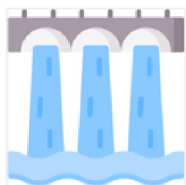
Fee: Volunteers to bear own cost of transportation to Kuching International Airport, meals and accommodation provided*

WHAT WILL YOU BE DOING?



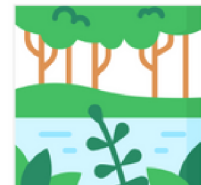
FIXING WATER SYSTEMS

Volunteers will get to immerse themselves in nature with hikes, a visit to the waterfall and other fun activities!

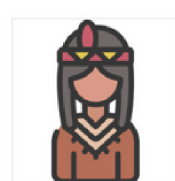

VOLUNTEER FAQ

1. Is there a fee to join this volunteer program?

You will need to bear your own transportation costs to Kuching International Airport, which will be the pickup point. So, if you need to take a flight there and back, that will be on your own expense. Meals and accommodation will be covered as you will be living with a family in Kg. Muk Ayun.

2. What time do I have to reach Kuching International Airport (KIA)?

Please arrange your transportation so that you'll be at the airport before 1pm on the 5th November. Our team will pick up all volunteers at 1pm.

3. How do I get to Kg. Muk Ayun?

After being picked up from the airport, our team will take volunteers to the village. The village is an hour away by road + another 10 minutes by boat. Similarly, at the end of the program, our team members will send you back to Kuching International Airport on the 12th November at 1pm.

4. How do I apply for the volunteer program?

Submit your application through the registration form. We will schedule an interview call once we process your registration form.

5. Can I join the volunteer program if I am only available for 3 days?

Volunteers are expected to commit fully for the whole program.

6. What do I need to bring?

Comfortable outdoor clothing, a hat/cap, sunscreen, personal medication (if required), insect repellent, water bottle. We will send a complete checklist to those who are selected.
